### DIRECTIONS

M4 Junction 12. A4 towards Newbury. At 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout right towards Pangbourne A340 In Tidmarsh turn right at The Greyhound Inn. Follow lane up Sulham Hill. Hall Place E.C. is at end of lane on right at T-junction  
**NB. Sulham Hill has been designated as 'Unsuitable for HGV's'**

#### Alternative Route

M4 Junction 12. A4 towards Reading. After approx 2.5 miles, Prospect Park on left, turn left at traffic lights into Liebenrood Road. At roundabout turn left. Follow road for approx. 2.5miles & turn right at T-junction (mini roundabout) into School Road. Left at mini-roundabout into Chapel Hill. At bottom of hill turn right then immediately left. Hall Place is at top of 3<sup>rd</sup> hill at fourth turning on the right

### RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) Entry to Hall Place Equestrian Centre assumes acceptance of the Show's rules and conditions.
- 2) No liability will be accepted by the organisers or proprietors for any loss, damage or accident to horses, spectators, competitors or property, however caused.
- 3) The Committee reserve the right to alter or cancel classes if necessary. Also to refuse entry if classes are full.
- 4) Refunds will only be given on production of Doctors/Vets certificates.
- 5) Correct riding attire must be worn when competing, riding hats must be worn when mounted and riding hats conforming to PAS 015 or above **MUST** be worn for all Show Jumping.  
It is **STRONGLY ADVISED** that Body Protectors are worn for Show Jumping.
- 6) Hall Place in a NO SMOKING establishment.
- 7) Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 8) Competitors numbers must be clearly visible.
- 9) Two refusals on the course results in elimination.
- 10) Wrong course results in elimination.
- 10) Riders sustaining a fall automatically retire.
- 11) The Judge's decision will be final. Objections must be made within ½ hour of the class results with a deposit of £20. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.

## UK RIDERS CHALLENGE 2018

- Qualifiers are held until 31<sup>st</sup> May 2018.
- Regional Finals are held in June & July 2018.
- National Finals will be held in August 2018 at Arena UK.
- Competitors do not need to be UKC&R members to enter the qualifiers but must join within fourteen days of qualifying if they wish to progress to Regional Finals.
- **No combination of horse and rider may qualify if they are affiliated to BS or BE.** If a combination of horse and rider qualify and they affiliate they are still eligible to continue to the Regional and National Finals.
- Juniors are under 16 on 01/01/18 for the 2018 Challenge. If they are a Junior when they qualify but subsequently become a Senior before the Regionals they must **still compete as a Junior** at the Regionals and Finals of the 2018 Challenge.
- All show jumping competitions are run under BS rules.
- All competitors with double clears will qualify.

### SUNSHINE TOUR 2018

Championship will be held at The All England Showground at Hickstead 13<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> September 2018 for unaffiliated and amateur competitors of all ages and abilities. Qualification: Riders placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> will qualify if clear in the first round. If less than 12 entries 1 per 3 qualify. ### CT RIDER SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS

Qualifier 60cm/~2'0. Horses/ponies not to have won any money BS.  
Qualifier 70cm/~2'3. Horses/ponies not to have won any money BS.  
Qualifier 80cm/~2'6, 85cm/~2'9 Open to all horse/pony & rider combinations.  
All horses and ponies must go clear in the first round in order to qualify.  
To qualify riders must have a CTR membership number BEFORE the competition – available from [www.chilternrider.co.uk/membership](http://www.chilternrider.co.uk/membership).  
Qualification cards need to be signed at the show.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horses and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> ponies qualify passed down as far as 5<sup>th</sup> place, (minimum of 6 entries).  
Championships will take place on 2<sup>nd</sup> September at Bury Farm EC.
