

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) **Entry to Hall Place Equestrian Centre Cross Country assumes acceptance of the Rules and Conditions.**
- 2) No liability will be accepted by the organisers or proprietors for any loss or damage, or accident to any horse, spectator, competitor or property however caused.
- 3) All competitors must wear hats without fixed peaks conforming to PAS015 and above. Correct riding wear and Body Protectors **MUST** be worn.
- 4) Competitors' numbers must be clearly visible.
- 5) Wrong course results in elimination.
- 6) Unseated riders **anywhere** on the course results in elimination.
- 7) Refusal at any fence incurs 10 penalties.
- 8) Three refusals at the same fence results in elimination.
- 9) The Judge's decision is **FINAL** in all cases. Any objections must be made within ½ hour of the class results with a deposit of £20. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is up held.
- 10) Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 11) Hall Place Equestrian Centre reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 12) Hall Place is a **NO SMOKING** establishment.

DIRECTIONS

M4 Junction 12. A4 towards Newbury. At 2nd roundabout right towards Pangbourne A340 In Tidmarsh turn right at The Greyhound Inn. Follow lane up Sulham Hill. Hall Place E.C. is at end of lane on right at T-junction

NB. Sulham Hill has been designated as 'Unsuitable for HGV's'

Alternative Route

M4 Junction 12. A4 towards Reading. After approx 3miles Prospect Park on left. Turn left at traffic lights into Liebenrood Road. At roundabout turn left. Follow road for approx. 2.5miles & turn right at T-junction

(mini roundabout) into School Road. Left at mini-roundabout into Chapel Hill. At bottom of hill turn right then immediately left.

Hall Place is at top of 3rd hill at fourth turning on the right.

CLASS 2 NOVICE Approx 2'6	Entry Fee £18 Elandlodge.com. National Hunter Trials 80cm Qualifier Rider any age. Horse/Pony any height. Combination not to have won a total of £50 at Cross Country. A more testing, longer course through woodland & open fields. May include bank, ditch, wall etc. Special rosettes for best 40 yrs & over!
CLASS 3 OPEN PAIRS Approx 2'6	Entry Fee £30 / Pair Elandlodge.com. National Hunter Trials 80cm Qualifier Rider any age. Horse/Pony any height. Dressing flags – 10 penalties if not ridden abreast through flagged section. Time judged 1 st horse to leave & 2 nd horse home.
CLASS 4 INTERMEDIATE OPEN Max 3'3	Entry Fee £18 Elandlodge.com. National Hunter Trials 90cm Qualifier Rider any age. Horse/Pony any height. A longer course including combinations, banks, ditches.
